As we come to the end of the Spring term and the end of Lent we look towards Easter in our Church calendar. Next week we celebrate Holy Week which begins with Jesus' joyful entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, His celebration of the 'First Mass' on Holy Thursday and His final journey carrying His cross on Good Friday.

Your children have been learning about these events of Holy Week and how we celebrate them in our church during the special Holy Week services. The Easter Season will begin with Jesus' resurrection on Easter Sunday. I hope you will be able to attend these services in your church with your children, while we teach them to know what it means to be Catholic, parents have the greater task of teaching them in practice.

<u>Lenten Reflection</u> - Ms Freeman and Year 5 pupils have been preparing the Easter Play also known as the Lenten Reflection. They are supported by Mrs Simon's choir and pupils from Years 1-6. All parents are welcome to attend the Easter Play in the hall on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March at 2.15pm. Refreshments will be served after the performance, donations of tea, coffee, sugar, cakes, bakes and other sweet treats would be much appreciated. All money raised will be donated to Cardinal Nichols Lenten Appeal.

<u>Cardinal Nichols' Lenten Appeal</u> - Our Catholic Social Teaching this term is to recognise the vulnerable in our society and to participate in ways to offer them support. Year1 – 6 each have planned fund raising activities which you will have been invited to support. Other fundraising events you are welcome to attend are; Year 5 Country Dance/ Coffee afternoon, Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March at 2.30pm and Year 4 concert 'Battle of Britain' / hot cross bun breakfast, Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March at 9.15am. Minimum donation of £3 or maximum £10 suggested for the Cardinal's appeal.

<u>Allergies</u> - We have several children and staff in school with severe allergies and children who are being assessed for allergies. Therefore, we do not allow chocolate or nuts, including peanut butter, in school for birthday treats or in packed lunches. (At pupils' request and as a special Easter treat we break this rule for the Easter Egg Hunt)

<u>School Roll</u> - I am sure you have seen the banners advertising places in all classes on the school and church railings. Fr Andrew also has one placed at St Patricks. Falling rolls is a concern for most schools across London and has serious consequences for school budgets and staffing. Your support in advertising our school would be much appreciated. You could tell new arrivals about our school or place our posters in your apartment buildings. We have spaces in Nursery, Reception and most other years.

<u>Summer uniform</u> - Summer uniform for boys consists of grey shorts and plain white polo shirt, navy v-neck jumper, black shoes and plain navy jacket without logo. Summer uniform for girls consists of pink (not red) check summer dress available from Marks & Spencer in store or by shopping online using the following <u>link</u> or by using the code T766487. navy or white v-neck cardigan and navy/black or white school shoes (no open toe sandals) and white/navy jacket without logo. Girls may also wear a plain white polo shirt with navy or grey skort / skirt, culottes or shorts. Nursery pupils wear plain coloured t-shirt and navy shorts and Reception wear plain white polo shirt and navy shorts.

<u>Sponsored Reading Bingo</u> - The PTA have devised a fantastic Reading Bingo activity for your children to complete during the month of March. Teachers will set the task in class, so keep an eye out for the sponsor form! A way to encourage reading for pleasure at home, whilst also raising money for books in class.

<u>School lunch menu April - October 2024</u> - The new menu will be added to the school website when it becomes available, please introduce your children to new foods on the menu and encourage them to try new dishes while in school.

<u>Water bottles</u> ~ Please make sure your children bring their water bottles to school each day, we have a water tap in the playground where children can refill water bottles.

<u>Lost property</u> - Please ensure each item of uniform is labelled so we can return lost items of clothing. Remember to rewrite names after washing as ink fades. Clothing left at the end of this term will be put into the clothing recycle scheme.

<u>Election Day</u> - The school be used as a Local Council Elections station on  $2^{nd}$  May. The school will remain open but children arriving late will be unable to access the school due to the reception area being closed off to the rest of the school. Please ensure your child arrives on time.
