I hope you had a restful half term. We have a busy term ahead, Mrs Moore our English Coordinator and the Parents' Fundraising group are planning World Book Day activities (details will follow soon) and we will present the Easter Reflection on Tuesday 26th March at 2:15pm in school.

This is the season of Lent when we fast, pray and give to charity. Pope Francis has asked that we take time to pray more during Lent as we prepare for Easter. Please make time to pray with your children and help them to learn the traditional prayers of the church and responses and prayers of the Mass.

At assembly today we introduced pupils to the 'Lent Mission Calendar' which is part of the Lent display in the hall. Parents are welcome to come along. She will also support Fr Alex teaching Years 2 and 3 about The Eucharist and The Mass. Parents are the first teachers of their children and they will learn more from you through active participation in prayer and worship. We will invite you to join your children in these prayer opportunities.
