Welcome back for the 2023-2024 school year. I am sure that all the children will settle well into their new classes and work hard for their teachers in the year ahead. All staff attended training on Monday and Tuesday and key priorities were RE, Speech and Language, Phonics, Writing and Reading, teachers will keep you informed about your children's needs this year and trust you will support us in our efforts to raise standards across the whole curriculum.

<u>Catholic life of the school</u> - Fr Alex will celebrate Mass to pray for a blessing for our new school year on Friday 8th September, Feast of The Birth of Our Lady. Parents are welcome to join us in English Martyrs Church at 9.30am.

<u>Return of Contact Forms</u> – Each child has been given a Pupil Contact details sheet to enable us to update our records. We must have up to date pupil allergy information and contact details. Please complete one per child and return to school this week. You will shortly receive via text a Home School Agreement and Pupil Permission online Google forms. These must be completed one per child.

<u>Swimming</u> – Swimming will take place on Friday morning for Year 4 starting next week. Pupils should bring a swim costume, towel and hat. Goggles may be worn but are not obligatory.

<u>After school activities</u> – Afterschool multi-sports lessons resume next week on Tuesdays 3:15 until 4:15pm for pupils in Years 3 & 4 for this term. Year 1 and 2 can attend in the Spring term and Y5 and 6 in Summer term. Lessons cost £60 per child per term. Please register interest at the office. There is a maximum of 20 places available.

<u>Texting Service</u> - The school uses a texting service to inform parents of any changes to the normal school week. Please make sure that the school has up-to-date mobile telephone numbers so we are able to register you for this service. If you have an urgent enquiry please ring the school and speak to a member of staff.

<u>Condolences</u> - It is with great sadness we share with you the passing of one of our ex pupils, Jaiden Blondell who died suddenly just days before her 21st birthday. Jaiden completed a work placement in our Nursery. Her mother is also an ex pupil and her family are our Scarborough St neighbours. We extend our sincere sympathy to Jaiden's family at this sad time. Her funeral will be held in English Martyrs Church on Monday 11th September. May she rest in peace.
