Dear English Martyrs Parent/ Carer,

We would like to introduce ourselves as your School Health and Wellbeing team. We work with schools in Tower Hamlets to support children and young people around healthy lifestyle, immunisation, emotional health & wellbeing. We also provide additional support for children with long-term health conditions.

As your child is now in Reception class, later this year, they will have their **hearing** and **vision** screened and their **height** and **weight** measured as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). These measurements are taken to provide information about your child's health, growth, and development. You can access further information on the following links:

Please note, we let the school know about any children that require a further vision or hearing test following the screening. This is so they can support children at school while they are awaiting a follow up appointment. If you do not want us to share this with the school, you can let us know via the portal.

- Once registered, **please log-in** to read more about the growth, vision, and hearing measurements. If you **DO NOT** want your child's measurement to be taken, please **opt-out** on the portal. If you do not opt-out your child will be measured as part of the programme.

Once in the Portal, you will also be asked to fill out a **health questionnaire** about your child to help us understand if you need any additional support.

You can register on the portal using a smart phone or computer at home, school, or your local idea store. When using a computer, please use chrome, not internet explorer. For help, contact the School Health portal helpline on **020 395 84181.**
