You will need to complete a short form and upload your image, along with the title, which tells the story of the photograph. Each photograph must be saved as a J/JPEG and be smaller than 3MB. The closing date is June 18th. The final photographs will be available to view as part of a virtual exhibition on the National Portrait Gallery website in August. A selection of the photographs will be shown across the UK later in the year.

It would be wonderful if as many families as possible could enter, not only is it a lovely art project, it is also a way to explore feelings and emotions at this difficult time.
