Mission Statement

Rationale

In English Martyrs children are provided with an environment that allows them to participate in a range of activities that will benefit their physical well-being. We want our children to be successful members of their community who value themselves and each other.

We aim to enable children to:

- participate in a wide range of sporting activities
- develop and explore physical skills with increasing control and coordination
- select and use skills and ideas which show precision, control and fluency in their performance
- communicate and evaluate their own and other’s performance in order to improve their skills
- recognise working in a safe and controlled manner and to notice changes in their body temperature, heart rate and breathing
- understand the importance of a healthy and active lifestyle.

PE and Sports Programme 2019-2020

This year the £16,000 grant received from the government has enabled us to continue and further improve high quality PE and sports delivered within our curriculum.

The grant was spent in the following areas:

• Fit for Sport – Curriculum Sport 2 x 0.5 days per week	-	£8,800
• Volleyball	-	£1,800
• Gymnastics	-	£1,680
• Swimming for Year 3 and 4 pupils	-	£5,900
• Equipment & maintenance	-	£2,100

Pupils have shown increased confidence, engagement and success following greater participation in a variety of inter and intra school competitions. Playground games are timetabled to ensure each class has the opportunity to participate in sports and compete with each other.

The school has bought into a new SLA with Fit for Sport, who provide two Sports coaches on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons. In addition to Curriculum sport the school has made provision for pupils in Years 1 and 2 to play sports games with the two coaches during the lunch break.

Thanks to generous donations from Parents, a local business we have installed climbing frames in both playgrounds. These provide extra activities for pupils particularly those who need to develop their fine motor skills.
