

### In Literacy we will:

- Read 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' stories
- Draw the characters and the events in the stories
- Use sequencing and book language when retelling stories
- Write for a purpose (letters, wanted poster, design a bridge or a house)

### In Understanding the world we will:

- Make porridge and bear biscuits and talk about the changes in materials
- Learn about Summer weather
- Find information about wild animals such as bears
- Look at different homes such as cottages, castles and houses
- Learn about the five senses

### In Maths we will:

- Discuss numbers in traditional tales such as three bears and make number books.
- Use positional language in play
- Make up a story using the language of number/size
- Solve simple mathematical problems
- Describe properties of 2D shapes

### In Physical Development we will:

- Write our names
- Develop fine motor skills such as pencil control, using tweezers and scissors
- Learn how to look after ourselves e.g. personal hygiene, healthy eating and exercise
- Practice different ways of moving such as hopping, skipping, twirling and galloping

### In Personal and Social Development we will:

- Talk about how to stay safe-stranger danger
- Learn how to adapt behaviour in different situations
- Talk about how to make friends
- Learn how to persevere when they find things difficult

### In Expressive Arts and Design we will:

- Design and make traditional tale props and characters for role play
- Act out traditional tale stories
- Use construction resources to make bridges, castles and houses
- Make dens in the garden

### In Religious Education we will:

- Listen to the story 'Jesus lives'
- Make our own prayers
- Learn about Mary

### In Communication and Language we will:

- Use story language to make up and act out traditional tale/fairy-tale stories
- Learn the wild animals names
