



History

In History, we will develop historical knowledge and understanding of the life and significance of Neil Armstrong. Children will identify the kit needed for an expedition and compare the equipment taken by Armstrong on his voyage. They will also discover navigation techniques and learn about the materials used by Armstrong.

English

Geography
