In English we will be:

- Reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl
- Developing narrative and writing poetry
- Reading poetry – Chocolate Cake by Michael Rosen
- Using, volume, intonation and expression to speak clearly in all lessons
- Revising grammar of compound and complex sentences to develop writing in all subjects

In Science we will be:

- changing the states of materials and:
- Observing the effect of heat and cold on materials
- Investigating the time taken for a chocolate button to melt
- Observing reversible and irreversible changes over time in salt, plaster, flour, cocoa
- use scientific language to discuss ideas and communicate findings
- use diagrams, illustrations, tables and charts to present ideas

• In History we will:

- Learn about the Mayans – a central American, non-European society that provides contrast with British history
- Learn about links with the Caribbean and the growing conditions for the cacao tree

In Art/Music we will:

- develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form.
- look at the work of Frieda Kahlo
- Looking at 60s Pop Art -Andy Warhol – using art to give value to the everyday
- learn the violin or cello

In Geography we will :

- Use maps to locate North and South America, Central America and Caribbean countries
- Understand key aspects of human geography, inc trade links

In Design Technology we will...

- evaluate an existing product
- understand how products are designed for a purpose
- design and make a paper bag
- make labelled drawings from different views showing specific features.
- Make rice crispie cakes and ice cream to observe the effect of heating and cooling

In Religious Education we wil:

- learn about God's call to the early prophets and their response
- understand the importance of trusting in God
- know the response of John the Baptist, Mary, Joseph and Zechariah to God
- understand that sometimes trust in God is not easy
