Why are their 2 testaments? How are they different? Ch to list some stories they know; what is their favourite. Why -how does it help them? Others?	Read the story of Abraham PB p8,9 Think about the difficulties leaving home. How would Abraham convince Sarah? What does this tell us about Abraham? Sarah? God? Explain to the pupils how Abram is the same person as Abraham but God changed his name to reflect his new life.	Read PB p11,12, discuss the fairness of having a favourite. Were Joseph's brothers right to be angry? Read Gen 40:9-19 How did the prisoners feel when Joseph interpreted their dreams? Read Gen 41:1-7 what were Pharaoh's dreams? Read Gen 42:7 What is the connection between Joseph's first dream and what has happened? Talk about questions before answering in books. What did the brothers tell their father?	Read PB p15, 16 Reflect on God's promise to Moses. What did god ask Moses to do? Write a diary entry. What happened at the Passover? Read Exodus 14:21-29 What happened? What happened next? How do we know God kept his promise to Moses? Cartoon of Moses' life The bulrushes, The Burning Bush, The Passover, The Exodus	Watch the PP of David's brothers. What did they have to learn? Read PB p19 Reflect on God's reasons for choosing who he does. Draw a heart what would God find in it? Read p20, 21 Why did David offer to fight the giant? How could you use David's experience to help you? What are the difficulties that people have? How could this help them?	Read the quotations on P 22. Discuss with your partner.
