In Geography we will be...

- Plot distances of soldiers travelling to the Front.
- Compare pre and post WW1 borders and country names
- Look at and study local WW1 memorials.

In Science we will be...

- Beginning lifecycles topic with regard to plants - linked to Autumn and beginnings.
- Life Cycle of Plants - pollination- fertilisation- dispersal
- Reproduction of flowering and non-flowering plants
- Life cycles of a range of animals including birds, mammals, insects and amphibians.

In Art/Music we will be...

- Drawing seeds - close observation.
- Exploring the work of Paul Nash - A war artist from World War 1
- Exploring *Lark Ascending* - Vaughan Williams
- Exploring songs from World War 1 - Pack up your troubles.
